In preparation for the upcoming 2010 Bermuda Captive Conference (BCC), the Bermuda Insurance Management Association (BIMA), in conjunction with the BCC organizing committee, are once again pleased to invite Bermudians to apply for one of 2 ICCIE Scholarship Awards for the **Associate in Captive Insurance (ACI)** professional designation.

The ACI professional designation provides an educational standard for professionals in the captive insurance industry and is evidence of an individual's commitment to and knowledge of the captive industry.

Applicants should be either currently working in the captive industry or be strongly considering a long term career in the industry. Applicants should submit the following:
